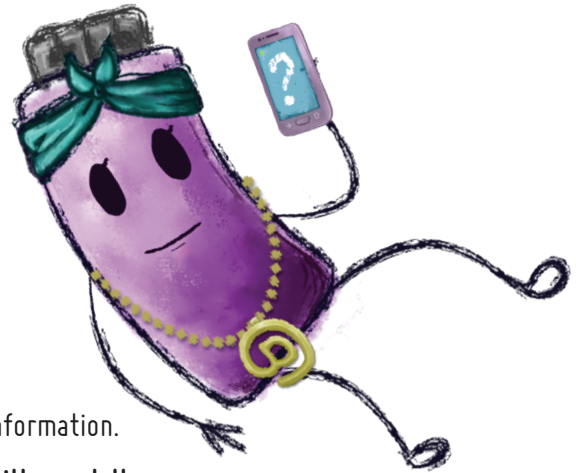
There are so many good websites on the internet but there is so much information to take in.

Anyone can put a website up online and sometimes the people who make these websites can make mistakes or tell you the wrong information. If you are doing a project in class or looking up information for homework, how can you tell if the information is right or not?

You can use these 4 questions when you are looking at a new website...

Golden Rules — Ask yourself these questions!

- Who owns the website?
- Why did they build it?
- What will they do with your information?
- When was it last updated?



One website that you can trust is called Scoilnet. It contains loads of trustworthy information.

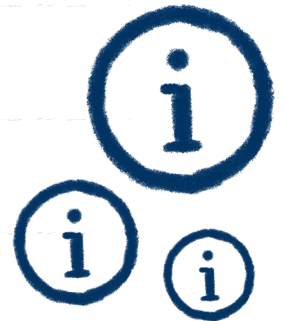
Log onto the Scoilnet website, www.scoilnet.ie/, and run through the 4 questions with an adult.
